2014 Japanese Direct Investment Survey: Summary of Michigan Results (as of October 1, 2014)


The Consulate General of Japan in Detroit annually surveys Japanese-owned facilities and Japanese nationals in Michigan. As the 2014 data indicate, Japanese investment contributes significantly to the state economy.

FACILITIES

Japan is a leading foreign investor in Michigan with 487 facilities. The majority of Japanese facilities (266) operate in the manufacturing sector, 62% of which are automotive related. There are 117 commercial trade operations, accounting for 24% of all facilities.

EMPLOYMENT

Japanese facilities provide 38,339 jobs in Michigan, 95% of which are held by local residents.

GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION

The southeast region's 395 facilities are primarily in the R&D, engineering, sales, and service industries, which provide 21,444 jobs. Facilities in other regions are predominately in the manufacturing sector, and provide 16,895 jobs.
