SUMMARY OF CONTRIBUTIONS

A Toledo native and graduate of Brandeis University, Mr. Silverman has contributed to deepening understanding of Japanese culture through *netsuke* in the United States.

Mr. Silverman, who began collecting *netsuke* around 1968, acquired approximately 1,500 *netsuke* by the time he left Japan in 1980, and has become one of the most prominent *netsuke* collectors in the world. He has made generous donations of *netsuke* to the Toledo Museum of Art since the 1980s, and after his large gift of ceramic *netsuke* in 2009, the Museum opened an exhibition titled "Life in Miniature" in 2010. The *netsuke* gallery was installed in the Museum in 2013, and has become a favorite space for many visitors.

Mr. Silverman has also donated many other types of Japanese art to the Museum, including prints, scrolls, ceramics, and devoted much of his life to collecting, teaching, lecturing, and writing on Japanese arts.
