Applications for the **2020 Japanese Studies** are now available!



The MEXT Japanese Studies Scholarship offers enrolled university students the opportunity to study in Japan for a 1-year time period and can be used as a study abroad program.

Scholarship Includes:

- *Round-trip airfare to and from Japan
- *University tuition and fees covered
- *Monthly stipend for living expenses

Eligibility:

- *U.S. Citizenship (to apply through U.S.)
- *Must be an undergraduate student majoring in field related to Japanese language/culture.
- *Must have studied Japanese at a college/university for a period of one year or more as of September 1, 2020.
- *Born between April 2, 1990 and April 1, 2002

One Year Scholarship Term:

September/October, 2020 through
September/October, 2021

Application Deadline: **February 19th**
Applicants must be available for
testing and interviews: **March 4th**
