**Note: Applicants who submit late and/or incomplete applications may be disqualified. Please carefully read the Application Guidelines (including notes) and follow all instructions.**

**Application Instructions:**

1. Follow the link to the Study in Japan website ([Undergraduate](#)) or ([Specialized Training](#))
2. Carefully read the *Application Guidelines* for either Undergraduate or Specialized Training students.
3. Download and complete the *Application Form*.
4. Download and complete the *Placement Preference Form*
5. Have your doctor complete the *Certificate of Health*.
6. Collect other supplemental documents (see Application Guidelines)
7. Number each document, as instructed in the Application Guidelines.
8. **Mail** all of your application materials in one packet to the address above. Applications must be received at the office by June 9<sup>th</sup> in order to be considered (NOT post-marked by).
9. Notify our office via email ([rhea.young@dt.mofa.go.jp](mailto:rhea.young@dt.mofa.go.jp)) when you mail your application.

**Eligibility (Refer to Application Guidelines, p. 1-3):**

- Applicants must be U.S. citizens living in Michigan or Ohio. Please contact the nearest Japanese Embassy/Consulate in your area if you do not reside in our jurisdiction. If you possess and maintain dual citizenship with Japan and the U.S., you are not eligible to apply for the Japanese Government Scholarship unless you renounce your Japanese citizenship prior to your departure.
- Your date of birth must be between April 2, 1998 and April 1, 2005

**Preliminary Selection**

Qualified candidates will be contacted and asked to undergo testing at the Consulate General of Japan in Detroit in-person on June 30<sup>th</sup>.

Please note that depending on the COVID-19 situation and travel restrictions, there is the possibility that applicants will not be able to depart for Japan even after being selected as scholarship students.
