announced that they have reopened to the public, subject to ongoing public-health safety precautions and restrictions. In Michigan, these include the **DeVos Japanese Garden** at the Meijer Gardens & Sculpture Park in Grand Rapids, the Tokushima-Saginaw Friendship Garden at the Japanese Cultural Center in Saginaw (pictured below), and the Japanese Garden at Cranbrook
