



The Consulate General of Japan in Detroit annually surveys the number of Japanese business facilities and the total employment at Japanese business facilities in Ohio. As the 2023 data indicate, Japanese investment contributes significantly to state and local economies.

- 434 Japanese owned facilities in Ohio
- 68,796 direct jobs; highest total in the Midwest
- Japan remains among the leading foreign direct investors in Ohio


## JAPANESE BUSINESS FACILITIES

The number of Japanese business facilities peaked at 498 before the effects of the pandemic.



## TOTAL EMPLOYMENT

Employment at Japanese business facilities has remained stable with a slight decrease due to the pandemic.



## **GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION**

Japanese business facilities are relatively dispersed in the Columbus, Cincinnati and Cleveland areas. Cincinnati has the highest number of Japanese business facilities (41) and Marysville has the highest number of employment (7,047) as of October 2023.
