



Japanese Direct Investment in Michigan (as of October 1, 2023)

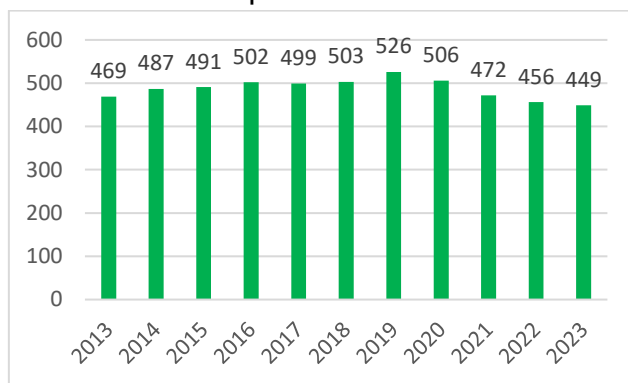


The Consulate General of Japan in Detroit annually surveys the number of Japanese business facilities and the total employment at Japanese business facilities in Michigan. As the 2023 data indicate, Japanese investment contributes significantly to the state economy.

- Japan remains among the leading foreign direct investors in Michigan

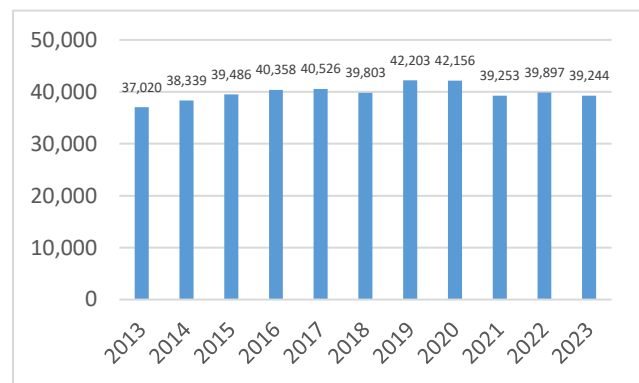
JAPANESE BUSINESS FACILITIES

The number of Japanese business facilities peaked at 526 before the effects of the pandemic.



TOTAL EMPLOYMENT

The total employment at Japanese business facilities has increased by about 6% since 2013.



GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION

The majority of facilities are located in southeast Michigan and are primarily R&D, engineering, sales, and service operations. Novi has the highest number of Japanese business facilities (102) and Battle Creek has the highest number of employment (4,724) as of October 2023.
