Experiencing Setsubun in Saitama

Setsubun (節分) is a Japanese holiday marking the transition from winter to spring with bean-throwing (mamemaki). This time of year is believed to bring out demons, and throwing roasted soybeans is a way to drive them away and welcome good fortune. During the celebrations, people wear demon masks and others throw beans at them while chanting "鬼は外!福は内!" ("Oni wa soto! Fuku wa uchi!"), meaning "Demons out! Fortune in!"
